

Blaine Festival Oreo Stacking Contest Rules

- Each contestant has 30 seconds to stack Oreos as high as possible without toppling the Oreos over
 - Official Nabisco time limit
- The Judge will declare “Go” at the start of the stacking competition
- The Judge will declare “Stop” when the 30 second time limit is up
- Each contestant MUST start and stop at the Judge’s command
- Create ONE vertical stack of Oreos without using any props, glue or adhesive
 - Cannot use anything to stabilize the stack
- Only ONE Oreo cookie may be stacked at a time
- Once an Oreo is placed it and hand removed, the Oreo cannot be moved
- The Oreo stack CANNOT be straightened during stacking
- Oreo stack must remain STANDING for 3 seconds after the 30-second time limit
- Oreo stacks are measured by number of Oreo cookies used NOT how high the stack is
- Judges will record the Highest number of Oreo cookies stacked before tumbling
- Judges decision is final
- Contests will be run consecutively when a minimum of 6 contestants have registered
- Two Age Groups & Two Start Times
 - 11 & Under – at 5:30 p .m.
 - 12 to 16 – at 6:00 p.m.
- Prizes awarded in both categories
 - Winner: Receive a pkg. of Oreos
 - Prizes awarded after each round
 - Contestants may only win ONCE
