

Blaine Festival Safety Plan
Subject to Change per Covid Guidelines

To stay in compliance with the City of Blaine and Minnesota Department of Health's current COVID-19 social distancing policies, the following rules and policies must be followed by all participants, attendees, volunteers at the 2022 Blaine Festival.

Attendance and/or participation in the 2022 Blaine Festival is **not allowed** if participant/attendee:

- Has a fever or is not feeling well
- Has a cough
- Has difficulty breathing
- Has had signs or symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Was tested positive for COVID-19 or has been exposed to someone who has tested positive and is still in quarantine.

General good hygiene practices should be followed:

- Follow face-covering requirements and guidelines.
- Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet at all times from others, except for members of the same household.
- Coughs or sneezes should be covered
- Used tissues or paper towels must be disposed of in trash cans
- After using the restroom, hands should be washed for 20 seconds ; if soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Do not share drinks, or food

Protocols and Social Distancing:

- Hand Sanitizing Stations will be set up throughout Aquatore Park for participant/attendee use
- Masks must be worn inside all structures (pavilions & tents included)
- Masks are encouraged to be worn outside but are not required
- A group activity will not have more than 30 participants including performers.
- Each building will have a capacity level for the amount of people who can be in the structure at one time
- Entrances to events will be marked with **Enter Only** and **Exit Only** signs
- There will be social distancing signs throughout Aquatore Park
- **Rules and signs will be posted!**
